

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ENTRY INTO THE COMPETITION

Entry into the Faces & Places Photography Competition (the "Competition") is open to all University of Wollongong students and staff aged 18 years or over. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Competition entries will begin at 9:00 (AEDT) on 1st September 2017 and closes at 0:00 (AEST) on Friday 30 September 2017 (the "Competition Period"). Entries received after midnight (AEDT) 30th September 2017 will not be eligible.

To enter the Competition and be eligible to win, entrants must:

be over 18 years of age;

be a current UOW student or current UOW staff; and

have entered their photograph via the appropriate process for the Category ("category"):

'Faces of the World' ("Faces") and 'Amazing Places' ("Places") using the online application form ("online application form") at clubs.uow.edu.au/news/facesandplaces

FACES / PLACES CATEGORIES

Photographs submitted will be judged in the category that is selected with the online application form

Photographs submitted must address each of the 'required' fields on the online application form in order to be eligible

Photographs submitted may be used in materials produced by the Student Engagement at UOW Pulse for use throughout UOW, unless otherwise stated in the online application form

Photographs submitted will be automatically entered into the 'People's Choice' category unless otherwise stated in the online application form

WINNERS & PRIZES

The Prize Winners of category 1 and 2 will be notified by e-mail on Tuesday 4th October, and published to UOW Student Life Facebook page (facebook.com/uowstudentlife)

There are two (2) prizes in total, one (1) prize per category. The Prizes are a gift voucher for STA Travel valued at \$200.00.

It is a condition of accepting the Prize that the Prize winner must comply with any conditions of use of the Prize and UOW Pulse directions or requirements.

The prize is not transferable or redeemable for cash. The Prize or any element of the Prize cannot be exchanged for any other Prize. The contents of the Prize will be at UOW's sole discretion. The Prize is subject to availability and the terms and conditions of the entities supplying the Prize.

If a Prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, UOW reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or greater value, subject to State Regulation.

Only one Prize will be awarded per category (three in total).

UOW Pulse makes no warranties or representations about the fitness for purpose or suitability of any Prize and will not accept responsibility for the quality or fitness for any purpose of any Prize, or the failure of any Prize to be of merchantable quality.

GENERAL

The judges' decision is final and UOW will not enter into correspondence about why one or another entrant did or didn't win. UOW Pulse reserves the right to request the Prize Winner to provide proof of identity, proof of residency at the nominated prize delivery address, in order to claim the Prize. Proof of identification, residency and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of UOW Pulse. In the event that the Prize Winner cannot provide suitable proof, the Prize Winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

No responsibility will be taken by UOW Pulse for any changes in dates, times or cancellations or other arrangements that may prevent the Prize Winner from winning the Prize.

Subject to relevant state authority approval, UOW Pulse reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, at any time before the awarding of the Prize to cancel or vary the terms of the Competition or to vary or cancel the award of the Prize including, without limitation, circumstances where in UOW Pulse opinion (which it shall form in its absolute discretion):

a Prize Winner does not satisfy the Competition entry requirements; or UOW Pulse cannot conduct the Competition or award the Prize for any reason beyond its control.

Subject to relevant state authority approval, in the event that UOW Pulse cancels or varies the Competition or varies or withdraws the Prize it shall not: be liable to any person for any loss or damage (including loss or damage caused by any negligence) arising out of, or in connection with, such cancellation, variation or withdrawal; and be required to conduct the Competition at any other time.

A decision of UOW in relation to the conduct of the Competition is binding and conclusive and no correspondence will be entered into.

Entrants enter the Competition at their sole risk. With the exception of liability which cannot be excluded by law, UOW shall not be liable for any loss or damage which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of taking the Prize or entering the Competition.

UOW Pulse collects entrants' personal information (as that term is defined in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)) for the purpose of conducting and promoting this Competition (including, but not limited to, determining and notifying winners).
